Rama Devi Women's University Standards and Procedures for award of Ph.D. Degree (3rd amendment) Regulations, 2022

Rama Devi Women's University hereby makes the following amendments to *Rama Devi Women's University Standards and Procedures for award of Ph.D. Degree Regulations, 2021* in its Regulation Committee meeting held on dt. 06.09.2022. These Regulations may be called as "Rama Devi Women's University Standards and Procedures for award of Ph.D. Degree (3rd amendment) Regulations, 2022". They shall come into force from the date of its official notification.

A clause 5.11 is added to the RDWU Standards and Procedures for award of Ph.D. Degree Regulations, 2021 as:

"Clause 5.11: The validity of Ph.D. Coursework Certificate will be for two years (02 years) from the date of completion of coursework under RDWU".

The Clause 6.4 of the RDWU Standards and Procedures for award of Ph.D. Degree Regulations, 2021 shall be read as:

"Clause 6.4: The Registration of Ph.D. is effective from the date of DRC meeting held for finalisation of synopsis. The year is to be mentioned in the registration number as the year of said DRC meeting. The duration of the Ph.D. programme can be extended beyond the limit of six years on recommendation of the authority. After 08 years, the registration shall be cancelled automatically."

The Clause 7.5 of the RDWU Standards and Procedures for award of Ph.D. Degree Regulations, 2021 shall be read as:

"Clause 7.5: Only a full-time regular teacher of this University / affiliated College can act as a Supervisor/Co-supervisor. The external supervisors are not allowed. However, Co-Supervisor can be allowed from the same Department of this University with proper justification citing specialization or in inter-disciplinary areas from other Departments of the same University or from other related institutions with the approval of the DRC."

A clause 15.2 (Viii) is added to the RDWU Standards and Procedures for award of Ph.D. Degree Regulations, 2021 as:

"Clause 15.2 (Viii): The scholar has to attach papers published in journals based on her Ph.D. research as Appendices to the thesis during binding. The papers must reflect the name of journal, title of paper, names of authors, volume & issue no., ISSN, doi, and URL. The scholar must be the first author and the supervisor as the second author subject to maximum three authors of the paper. In addition, scholar is required to make appendices by attaching certificates of seminar presentation reflecting paper title and authors' name.
